<b>Workshop Title</b>	<b>Age Group</b>	<b>About the workshop</b>
Every story is a song	5 and 8 years	'Where words fail, music speaks', Hans Christian Andersen. Each rhyme, limerick or a song tell a story. Here is a workshop, where participants will discover songs that tell a story. Folk ballads often suggest a larger tale. Come listen to music and retell the story in the song in your own words.
Vocabulary fun	5 and 8 years	Come children, come galore! This is a super fun filled workshop where children will play word games, crosswords, puzzles, mazes, word searches related to the very authentic and fun Christmas terminology. In this session they will come across new words that will improve their language. So, join us for unlimited fun!
Write a letter to Santa	5 and 8 years	Children have a wish list for Santa where they have cute and innocent desires to ask. This Christmas write a letter to Santa with all your wishes and the best entries would be rewarded. The children will be given the exposure to letter writing which will enhance their writing skills.
Let's find Santa	5 and 8 years	This workshop brings along a bag full of Christmas fun for children and helps enhance communication skills all along. With stories, songs, games and puzzles children will rejoice a magical day.
Create a dream for future	9 to 13 years	What do children dream about the future? Let this workshop help them share their ideas on what the future could be through interactive activities. They will explore the future through poems, visualizations and present a message about an issue that is important to them and can bring effective change in our society.
Travel writing	9 to 13 years	Travel writing is a fun and interesting activity. In this workshop children will be writing about their experience from recent vacations. It will help children to think creatively and, in the process enjoy writing
Writing a blogpost	9 to 13 years	What is blogging? And what sets it apart from other forms of creativity? What separates a blog from say, a newspaper article, is "voice". In this session, children will learn how to identify their target audience, write focused blog posts on themes given to them by the facilitator which will range from writing about themselves to current topics such as climate change, deforestation, and cultural heritage.

Speak right speak bright	9 to 13 years	Become a world class orator with global articulation skills. Learn enunciation, modulation, drama, story- telling and stage presence through different activities. A child needs to overcome the fear of the stage and performing in front of a large crowd from the very beginning. Come gain experience and learn to communicate with ease.
