

MAKE UP BRUSHES

FOUNDATION BRUSH

May have a flat end or paddle end. These are usually made from natural hair. Will give heavier coverage than using fingers or sponge.



BLUSHER BRUSH

Again these may have a rounded or angled end.

To apply colour all over use the rounded brush:



to apply to cheekbone or apple use

The angled brush:



EYESHADOW SHADER

Usually paddle shaped, they come in different widths. Use to apply the main shadow colour.



ANGLE SHADOW BRUSH

Use for detail colour on the crease of eyelid or outer corner. Also useful for applying shadow under the bottom lashes or extending the shape of the eye at the corners.



EYELINER BRUSH

Very narrow brush used for fine detail especially applying liquid or cake liners around the lash line. The angled ones are sometimes easier to work around the contours of the eye socket.



LIP BRUSH

Use to hygienically apply all types of lip product to the lips. Helpful when correcting lip shapes.



MASCARA BRUSH

Used to hygienically apply mascara to lashes. Come in many different widths and sizes to create natural to very full voluminous lashes.
