Recognition of International Dimension in Schools (RIDS—formerly ISA/IDS) is a British Council framework that recognises schools that build international awareness and global citizenship through curriculum-based work.



Why RIDS:

- Make international learning visible across the school
- Plan curriculum-based international activities across the year
- Include partner-school collaboration in key activities
- Engage learners across age ranges (not just one class)
- Show impact on learners, teachers and the wider community
