SMOKEY EYE COLOUR WITH GLITTER

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The following will provide you with the correct procedure to apply a smokey eye colour with glitter

PROCEDURE

Step 1	Prime the clients eyes with a primer using a flat shader brush
Step 2	Using a crease brush and selecting a transition shade of your choice, you want to begin to apply the shade to the crease of the eye. Applying the product in a sweeping motion going backwards and forwards from the inner to the outer edges of the eye
Step 3	Using a darker shade, you want to begin to apply this shade also to the crease, blending both colours as you go, again you should do this using a sweeping motion.
Step 4	Once you're happy with the crease colour you want to add another shade to the lower lid by using a flat shader brush.
Step 5	Once the lid colour has been applied, take your crease shader brush and blend in the crease colour to the lid colour.
Step 6	A darker crease colour should now be chosen and applied to the outer corner of the eye with a shader brush. For a more dramatic look you should build the colour up by applying further product. Ensure that you are blending all colours as you progress.
Step 7	Go back to the lid shade and apply further product to the lid to make the colour more pigmented.
	You now are going to apply eyeliner to the eye
Step 8	Using a gel liner and a thin make up brush (or paint brush), you should ask your client to close their eye and draw a line along the upper lash line.
Step 9	To make the eye bolder, you should get a black shade and add it to the outer corner of the eye. Blend it in with the other colours.
Step 10	Apply the transition colour to the crease again and blend
Step 10	You are now going to apply colour to the lower lash line. Ask your client to open their eye and with a flat shader brush apply, use the outer crease colour and apply along the lower lash line. At the outer lower lash line you want to apply the black shade.
Step 11	You may wish to apply another layer of eye liner to the upper eyelash line again to make this stand out more.

Step 11	Take a pencil (kohl) eyeliner and apply the kohl the lower waterline. You may wish to smudge it to blend in with the lower eye shadow shade
	Applying glitter to the eye. If you don't have glitter glue, you are able to use Vaseline as a substitute
Note 1	Glitter should be placed where the highlight would go (around the outer edge of the eye (brow) down towards the top of the cheek
Step 12	Apply the glitter glue or Vaseline to the area specified above (Note 1). You can do this by using your finger
Step 13	Take a shader brush and select the colour of glitter you would like to use. Apply to the glitter glue/Vaseline from Step 12
Step 14	Adding highlight to the eye should be done by either using a brow highlight or a light colour eye shadow. You should apply this between the transition colour and the eyebrow (middle to outer brow).
Step 15	Add highlight to the inner corner of the eye
Step 16	Apply a mascara of choice to the upper and lower eyelashes to finish of the smokey eye look
