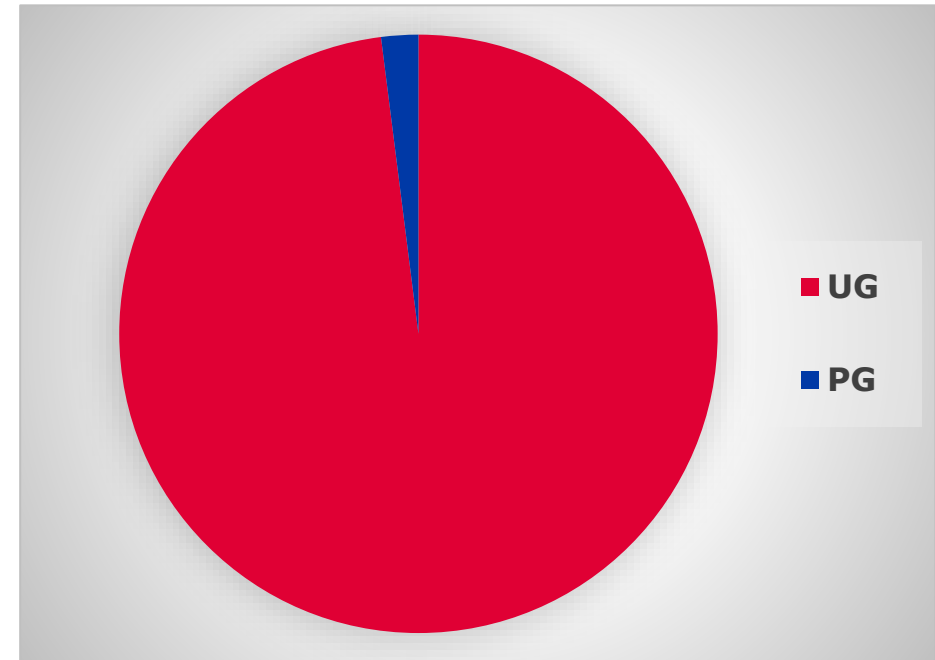
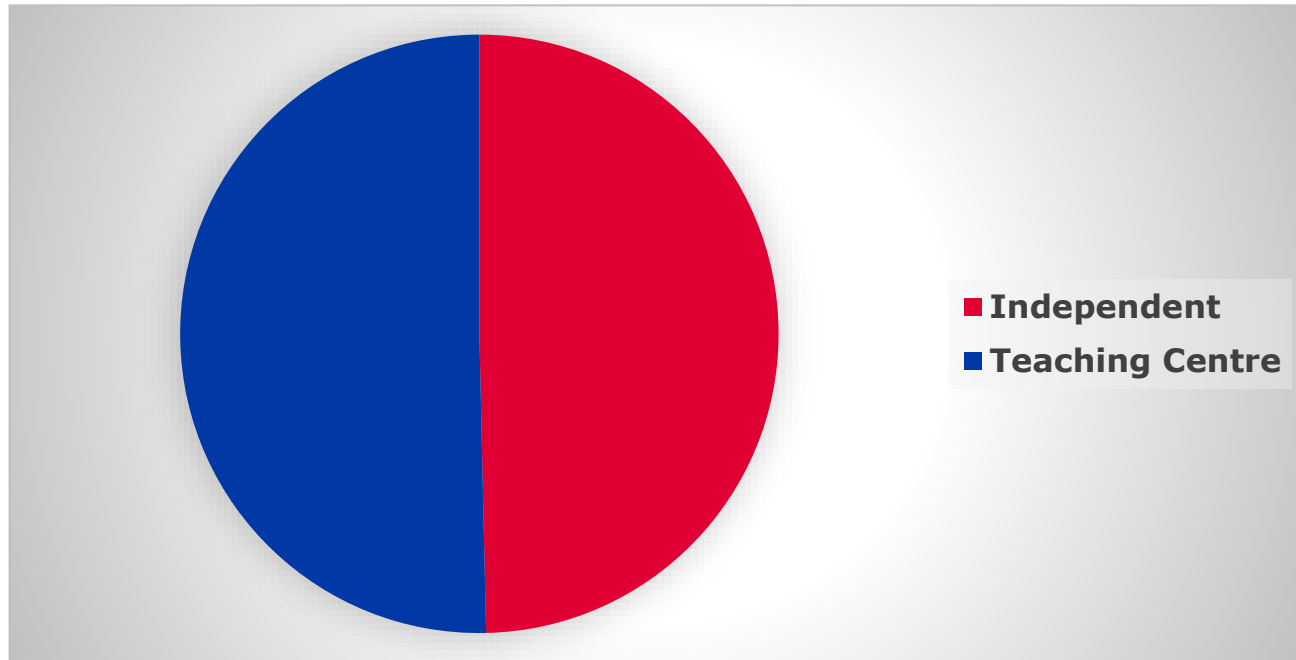

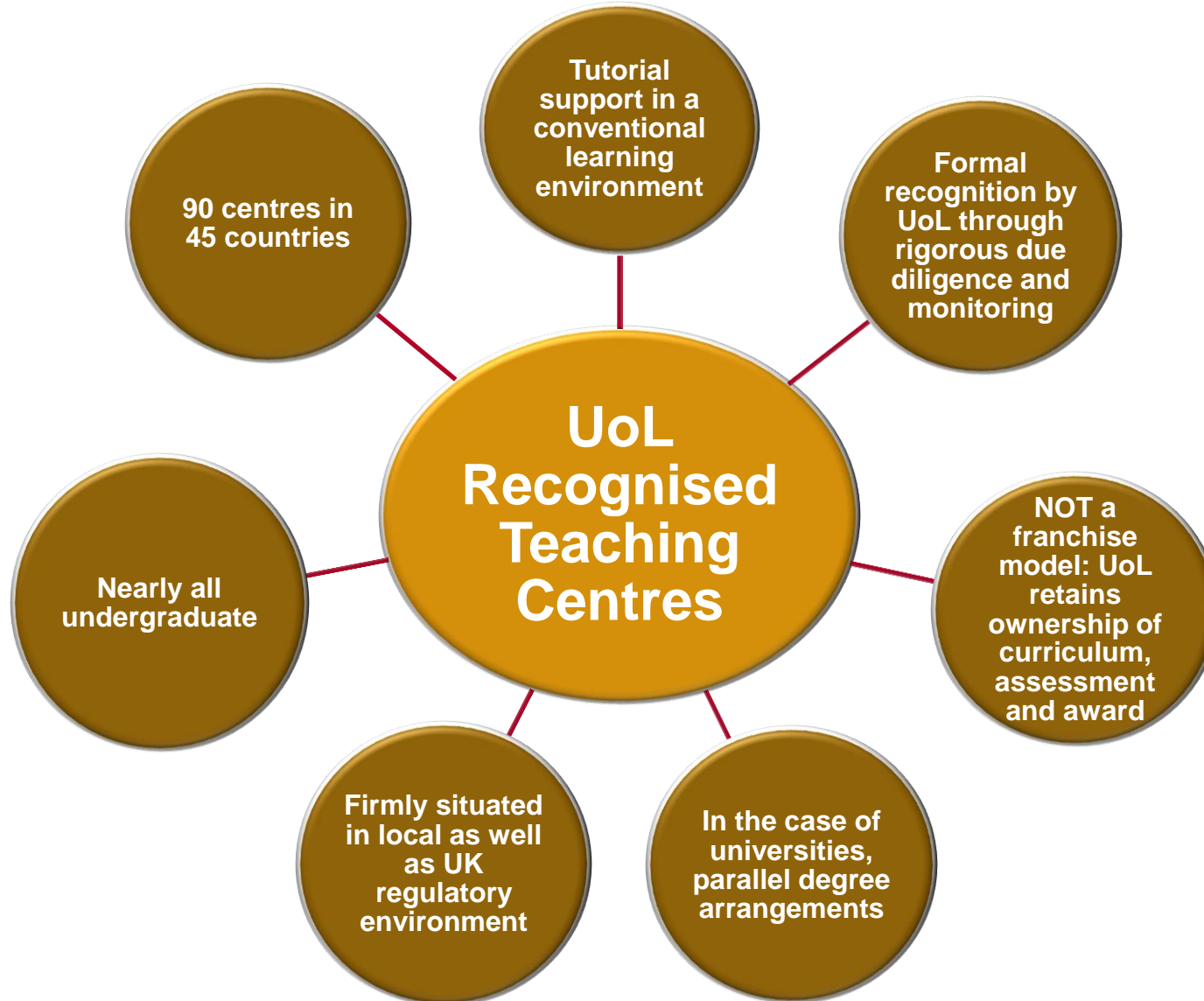


# Technology with blended provision: our students study independently online, or with additional campus-based support at UoL Recognised Teaching Centres

## UoL in India

- Longstanding engagement going back more than a century
- Notable alumni include Mahatma Gandhi, who registered for UCL (Law) in 1888-89, as well as the Bengali Nobel Laureate, writer and philosopher Rabindranath Tagore
- Currently there are 1,200 students in India taking University of London degrees
- Around half of these are undergraduates that receive academic and pastoral support from institutions in New Delhi and Mumbai.

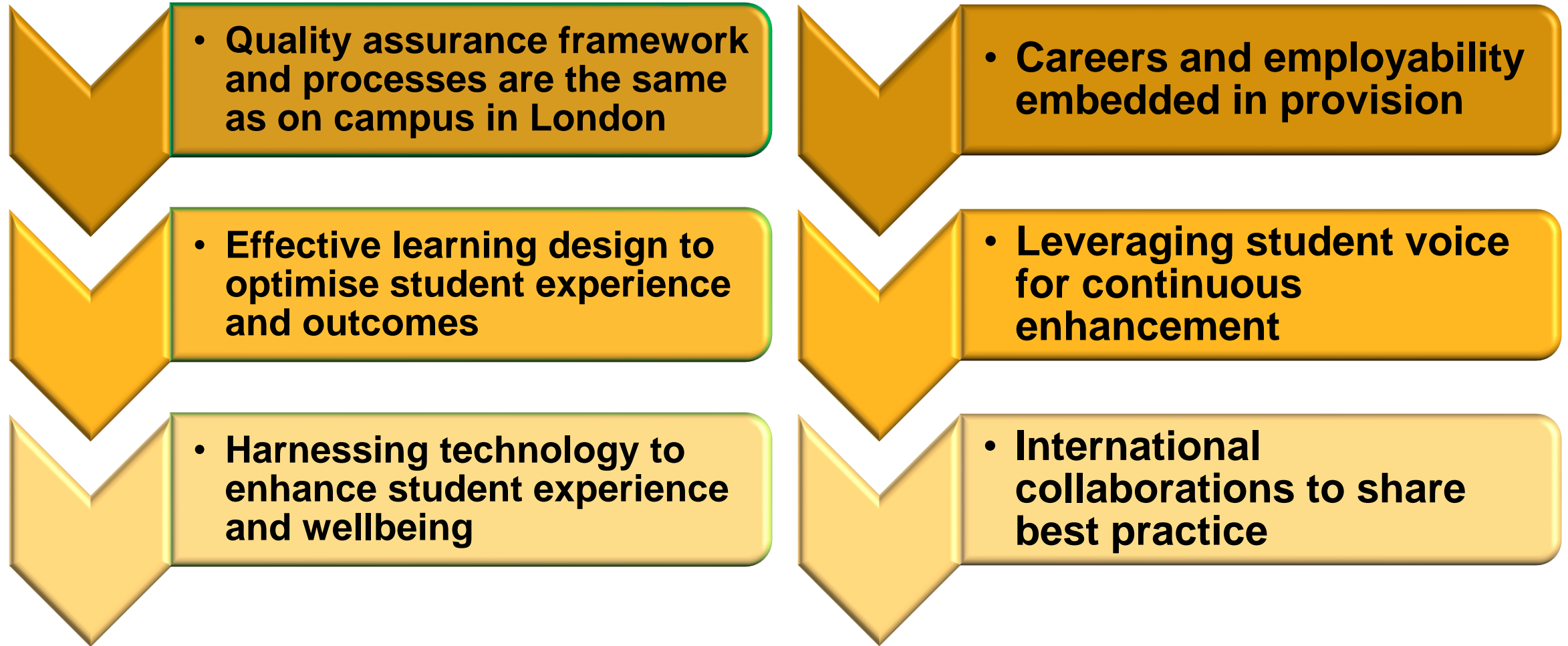


## Premise
